

Luckily, after the evening at Bearfoot Bistro, our first activity didn't start until 10 a.m. and Jon Fathom proved to be just the ticket. He

owns the Fathorn Stone Art Gallery and Studio and, after some great instructions, we were free to curve our own scapstone inukshuks. Although it was fairly low-key, with my slightly shaky hands, there could have been the potential for a mishap. Because, as we all know, hijinks like the previous evening can so often lead to tears.

My busband, the man who last did an art project in elementary school, sketched his inukshuk on the blackboard, then drew it again on the scapstone and curved and cut and sanded up a storm.

We were both so engressed in our minisculptures that we barely had time to grab hunch and get to Vincent and Cheryl Massey's gallery to do some weaving.

But here's the deal. First off, their gallery and home is hippieheaven-gorgeous; they're lovely people (be)s an amazing potter) and plaiting strips of wet cedar bark turned out to be a pretty darmed. cool thing to do.
